The Committee of the Whole is responsible for the annual budget; coordinating the Council’s relationship with the federal government as well as local, regional, and national entities; monitoring the progress of Council legislation through Congress; monitoring legislation in Congress that may affect the District; amendments to the District Charter; Council appointments to Boards and Commissions; public-space naming; street and alley acquisition and closing; reapportionment and realignment of the political subdivisions of the District; Council administration and personnel; District voting rights, statehood, and self-determination; grants management; government procurement; labor relations; truancy (jointly with the Committee on Education); District employees’ retirement; the development of the comprehensive plan and other matters pertaining to land use; revision and codification of Title 49 of the D.C. Official Code; public education matters exclusively concerning the University of the District of Columbia or the Community College of the District of Columbia; international business and affairs; and other matters assigned to it by these Rules or by the Chairman.
