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A BILL

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To officially designate the alley in Square 3094 that runs east and west between the 1800 blocks of 4th Street, N.W., and 5th Street, N.W., and the 400 blocks of Florida Avenue, N.W., and T Street, N.W., in Ward 1 as “Ernest Everett Just Court” after the acclaimed biologist and Howard University professor who lived in a property on the court.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the “Ernest Everett Just Court Designation Act of 2017”.

Sec. 2. Pursuant to sections 401, 403, and 421 of the Street and Alley Closing and Acquisition Procedures Act of 1982, effective March 10, 1983 (D.C. Law 4-201; D.C. Official Code §§ 9-204.01, 9-204.03, and 9-204.21), the Council officially designates the alley in Square 3094, that runs east and west between the 1800 blocks of 4th Street, N.W., and 5th Street, N.W., and the 400 blocks of Florida Avenue, N.W., and T Street, N.W., in Ward 1 as “Ernest Everett Just Court”.

Sec. 3. Transmittal.

The Chairman of the Council shall transmit a copy of this act, upon its effective date, to the Director of the District Department of Transportation, and the Office of the Surveyor.

Sec. 4. Fiscal impact statement.

1 The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement in the committee report as the fiscal
2 impact statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975,
3 approved October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47a).

4 Sec. 5. Effective date.

5 This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the
6 Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of Congressional review as
7 provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December
8 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the District of
9 Columbia Register.
