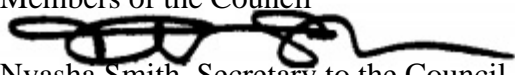

A BILL

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To designate the park located at 3rd and L Streets, N.E., in Ward 6, as Swampoodle Park.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the “Swampoodle Park Designation Act of 2017”.

Sec. 2. Pursuant to section 401 of the Street and Alley Closing Acquisition Procedures Act of 1982, effective March 10, 1983 (D.C. Law 4-201; D.C. Official Code § 9-204.01), the Council designates the park located at 3rd and L Streets, N.E., in Ward 6, as “Swampoodle Park”.

Sec. 3. Transmittal.

The Council of the District of Columbia shall transmit a copy of this act, upon its effective date, to the Director of the Department of Parks and Recreation.

Sec. 4. Fiscal impact statement.

The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement in the committee report as the fiscal impact statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975, approved October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47a).

Sec. 5. Effective date.

This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of congressional review as provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act approved December

31 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the District of
