A BILL

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To officially designate the school in Square 5561, Lot 822, bounded by Nicholson Street, S.E., Prout Street, S.E., 22<sup>nd</sup> Street S.E., and Minnesota Avenue, S.E., in Ward 8, as Lawrence Boone, Sr. School.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the "Lawrence Boone, Sr. School Designation Act of 2018".

Sec. 2. Pursuant to sections 401 and 422 of the Street and Alley Closing and Acquisition Procedures Act of 1982, effective March 10, 1983 (D.C. Law 4-201; D.C. Official Code §§ 9-204.01 and 9-204.22) ("Act"), the Council officially designates the school in Square 5561, Lot 822, bounded by Nicholson Street, S.E., Prout Street, S.E., 22<sup>nd</sup> Street S.E., and Minnesota Avenue, S.E., in Ward 8, as the "Lawrence Boone, Sr. School".

Sec. 3. Transmittal.

The Council shall transmit a copy of this act, upon its effective date, to the Mayor, the District of Columbia Public Schools, and the Office of the Surveyor.

Sec. 4. Fiscal impact statement.

The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement in the committee report as the fiscal impact statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975, approved October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47a).

34           This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the  
35 Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of congressional review as  
36 provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December  
37 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code §1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the District of  
38 Columbia Register.
