33	Sec. 2. Section 101 of the Abatement and Condemnation of Nuisance Properties Omnibus
34	Amendment Act of 2000, effective April 27, 2001 (D.C. Law 13-281; D.C. Official Code § 42-
35	3131.05(1)), is amended by adding a new subparagraph (C) to read as follows:
36	"(C) They Mayor may determine that a vacant building is not a blighted
37	vacant building when doors, windows, areaways, and other openings are secured by boards or
38	other non-permanent means of security secured but not replaced if the owner submits a building
39	permit application that certifies these items will be replaced as part of the renovation.".

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Sec. 3. Fiscal impact statement.

Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)) and publication in the District of 48 49 Columbia Register.
