Council Chairman Phil Mendelson announces a public roundtable before the Committee of the Whole on PR 23-70, the "Director of the Office of Planning Andrew Trueblood Confirmation Resolution of 2019." The roundtable will be held at **2:00 p.m. (or immediately following the preceding oversight hearing)**, on **Thursday, February 28, 2018** in the Council Chamber of the John A. Wilson Building.

The stated purpose of PR 23-70 is to confirm the appointment of Andrew Trueblood to be Director of the Office of Planning. Mayor Bowser designated Mr. Trueblood as Interim Director on November 8, 2018, and submitted his nomination to the Council on January 7, 2019. The Office of Planning guides land use and development in the District, including historic preservation. The purpose of this hearing is to receive testimony from government and public witnesses as to the fitness of Mr. Trueblood to be Director.

Persons wishing to testify are encouraged, but not required, to submit 15 copies of written testimony. If submitted by the close of business on February 26, 2019 the testimony will be distributed to Councilmembers before the roundtable. Witnesses should limit their testimony to four minutes; less time will be allowed if there are a large number of witnesses. If you are unable to testify at the roundtable, written statements are encouraged and will be made a part of the official record.
