A BILL

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To order the closing of a portion of the public alley in Square 369, in Ward 2.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the “Closing of a Public Alley in Square 369, S. O. 18003, Act of 2019”.

Sec. 2. Pursuant to section 201 of the Street and Alley Closing and Acquisition Procedures Act of 1982, effective March 10, 1983 (D.C. Law 4-201; D.C. Official Code § 9-202.01 *et seq.*) (“Act”), the Council finds that the 3-foot portion of the public alley in Square 369 is unnecessary for alley purposes and orders it closed, with title to the land to vest to Lot 71, Square 369, as shown on the Surveyor’s plat filed in S.O. 18003, and recorded in Book 200, Page 104.

Sec. 3. Transmittal.

The Council shall transmit a copy of this act, upon its effective date, to the Office of the Surveyor and the Office of Recorder of Deeds.

Sec. 4. Fiscal impact statement.

The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement in the committee report as the fiscal impact statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975, approved October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301-47.a).

Sec. 5. Effective date.

1 This act shall take effect upon its approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the
2 Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of congressional review as
3 provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December
4 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the District of
5 Columbia Register.
