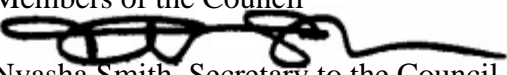





11 IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

14 To symbolically designate the public street on the 800 block of Decatur Street, N.E. as Downs  
15 Way.

16  
17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this  
18 act may be cited as the “Downs Way Designation Act of 2019”.

19  
20 Sec. 2. Pursuant to sections 401, 403a and 423 of the Street and Alley Closing and  
21 Acquisition Procedures Act of 1982, effective March 10, 1983 (D.C. Law 4-201; D.C. Official  
22 Code § 9-204.01, 9-204.03a, and 9-204.23), the Council symbolically designates the public street  
on the 800 block of Decatur Street, N.E. as “Downs Way”.

Sec. 3. Transmittal.

The Secretary to the Council shall transmit a copy of this act, upon its effective date, to  
the Director of the District Department of Transportation.

Sec. 4. Fiscal impact statement.

The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement in the committee report as the fiscal  
impact statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975,

23 approved October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47a).

24 Sec. 5. Effective date.

25 This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the  
26 Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of congressional review as  
27 provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December  
28 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code §1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the District of  
29 Columbia Register.
