Todd A BILL IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA To symbolically designate S Street, N.W., between New Hampshire Avenue, N.W., and 17th Street, N.W., as Kappa Alpha Psi Way. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the "Kappa Alpha Psi Way Designation Act of 2019". Sec. 2. Pursuant to sections 401, 403a, and 423 of the Street and Alley Closing and Acquisition Procedures Act of 1982, effective March 10, 1983 (D.C. Law 4-201; D.C. Official Code § 9-204.01), the Council renames the portion of S Street, N.W., between New Hampshire Avenue, N.W., and Seventeenth Street, N.W., in Ward 4, as "Kappa Alpha Psi Way.". Sec. 3. Transmittal. The Secretary of the Council shall transmit a copy of this act, after it becomes effective. to the District Department of Transportation. Sec. 4. Fiscal impact statement. The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement in the committee report as the fiscal impact statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975. approved October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47a).

32 Sec. 5. Effective date.

This act shall take effect after approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of congressional review as provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the District of Columbia Register.
