	(b) Allows other businesses to remit February and March sales taxes but defer actual payment until September 20, 2020.
Section 202	Small business grant program, including grants to non-profits and independent contractors (if they cannot qualify for Unemployment Insurance). May be administered by a third party.

Section 303	Extension of public benefit programs such as Alliance, TANF, and SNAP
Section 304	Limitation on price gouging and stockpiling
Section 305	Electric disconnect prohibition for all customers
Section 306	Gas disconnect prohibition for all customers
Section 307	DC Water disconnect prohibition for all customers
Section 308	Eviction prohibition for residential and non-residential tenants.
Section 309	Allowance for prescription drug refills before end of waiting period
Section 310	Extension of licenses and registrations (DMV, professional licenses, etc.)
Section 311	Homeless Services Reform Act contingency provisions
Section 312	TOPA deadline extension and Tenant Organization rights extension
Section 401	Provides DCPS Summer school calendar flexibility
Section 402	Research practice partnership review panel meeting extension of time
Section 501	ANC may meet less than 9 times per year and may do so remotely
Section 502	Suspension of meetings of other boards and commissions
Section 503	FOIA deadline extensions (clock will not toll during health emergency)
Section 504	Open meetings act compliance flexibility when remotely meeting
Section 601	Budget Submission Requirements – May 6, 2020 deadline
Section 602	Allow for Council to meet virtually
