

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33 IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA  
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38 To symbolically designate, on an emergency basis, 16th Street, N.W., between H Street, N.W.,  
39 and K Street N.W. as Black Lives Matter Plaza.

41 BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this  
42 act may be cited as the "Black Lives Matter Plaza Designation Emergency Act of 2020".

43           Sec. 2. Pursuant to sections 401 and 403a of the Street and Alley Closing and Acquisition  
44 Procedures Act of 1982, effective March 10, 1983 (D.C. Law 4-201; D.C. Official Code § 9-  
45 204.01 and 9-204.03a) (“Act”), and notwithstanding section 423 of the Act (D.C. Law 4-201;  
46 D.C. Official Code § 9-204.23), the Council symbolically designates 16th Street, N.W., between  
47 H Street, N.W., and K Street N.W. as Black Lives Matter Plaza.

48           Sec. 3. Section 10 of the Coronavirus Support Clarification Emergency Amendment Act  
49 of 2020, enacted June X, 2020 (D.C. Act 23-XXX; 67 DCR XXXX) is repealed.

50           Sec. 4. Applicability.

51           This act shall apply as of June 5, 2020.

52           Sec. 5. Fiscal impact statement.

53           The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement of the Budget Director as the fiscal impact  
54 statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975, approved  
55 October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47a).

56           Sec. 6. Effective date.

57           This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the  
58 Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), and shall remain in effect for no longer than  
59 90 days, as provided for emergency acts of the Council of the District of Columbia in section  
60 412(a) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 788;  
61 D.C. Official Code § 1-204.12(a)).
