

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18 IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA  
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22 To ceremonially designate the Frederick Douglass Court, S.E. in Square 5880 in Ward 8 as  
23 Elaine M. Carter Way.  
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26 BE IT ENACTED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this  
27 act may be cited as the "Elaine M. Carter Way Designation Act of 2019".

28 Sec. 2. Pursuant to sections 401, 403, and 421 of the Street Alley Closing and Acquisition  
29 Procedures Act of 1982, effective March 10, 1983 (D.C. Law 4-201; D.C. Official Code §§ 9-  
30 204.01, 9-204.03, and 9-204.21) ("Act"), and notwithstanding the requirements of section 404 of  
31 the Act (D.C. Official Code § 9-204.4) or 421(f) of the Act (D.C. Official Code § 9-204.21(f)),  
32 the Council:

33 (1) Ceremonially designates the Frederick Douglass Court, S.E. in Square 5880 in Ward  
34 8 as the Elaine M. Carter Way.

35 Sec. 3. Transmittal

1           The Council shall transmit a copy of this act, upon its effective date, to the Mayor, the  
2 District Department of Transportation, and the Office of the Surveyor.

3           Sec. 4. Fiscal impact statement.

4           The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement in the committee report as the fiscal  
5 impact statement required by section 602(c)(3) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act,  
6 approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(3)).

7           Sec. 5. Effective date.

8           This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the  
9 Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of Congressional review as  
10 provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December  
11 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)) and publication in the District of  
12 Columbia Register.

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
