6 IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

8 To symbolically designate Wiltberger Street, N.W., between S Street, N.W., and T Street, N.W.,
9 in Wards 1 and 6, as Cecelia's Way.

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA,

11 That this act may be cited as the "Cecelia's Way Designation Act of 2020".

13 Sec. 2. Pursuant to sections 401, 403a and 423 of the Street and Alley Closing and
14 Acquisition Procedures Act of 1982, effective March 10, 1983 (D.C. Law 4-201; D.C. Official
15 Code §§ 9-204.01, 9-204.03a, and 9-204.23), the Council symbolically designates Wiltberger
16 Street, N.W., between S Street, N.W., and T Street, N.W., as "Cecelia's Way".

17 Sec. 3. Fiscal impact statement.

18 The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement in the committee report as the fiscal
19 impact statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975,
20 approved October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47a).

21 Sec. 4. Effective Date.

22 This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the
23 Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of congressional review as
24 provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December
25 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the District of
26 Columbia Register.
