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A BILL

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To symbolically designate the 1800 block of Bruce Place, S.E., in Square 5880, in Ward 8, as Harold “Ike” Foster Way.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the “Harold “Ike” Foster Way Designation Act of 2020”.

Sec. 2. Pursuant to sections 401, 403a, and 423 of the Street Alley Closing and Acquisition Procedures Act of 1982, effective March 10, 1983 (D.C. Law 4-201; D.C. Official Code §§ 9-204.01, 9-204.03a, 9-204.23) (“Act”), the Council symbolically designates the 1800 block of Bruce Place, S.E., in Square 5880, in Ward 8, as “Harold “Ike” Foster Way”.

Sec. 3. Transmittal.

The Council shall transmit a copy of this act, upon its effective date, to the Mayor and the Director of the District Department of Transportation.

Sec. 4. Fiscal impact statement.

The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement in the committee report as the fiscal impact statement required by section 602(c)(3) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(3)).

Sec. 5. Effective date.

1 This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the
2 Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of congressional review as
3 provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December
4 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813: D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the District of
5 Columbia Register.

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
