Amendment:

Section 2 is amended as follows:

- (a) The lead in language is amended by striking the phrase "(c-2)" and inserting the phrase "(c-2) and (c-3)" in its place.
 - (b) A new amendatory subsection (c-3) is inserted to read as follows:
- "(c-3) Notwithstanding § 101 of the Criminal Fine Proportionality Amendment Act of 2012, effective June 11, 2013 (D.C. Law 19-317; D.C. Official Code § 22-3571.01), any person who violates any provision of an emergency order extended by the Mayor under the authority of subsection (c-2) shall, upon conviction, be punished by a fine of not more than three hundred dollars (\$ 300), or by imprisonment for not more than ten (10) days."

<u>Rationale</u>: This amendment would codify the enforcement provision contained in the underlying Mayor's Order 2021-002 for the duration of the emergency act.
