RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the "Displaced Workers Right to Reinstatement and Retention Congressional Review Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2021." Sec. 2. (a) On December 15, 2020, the Council adopted the Displaced Workers Right to Reinstatement and Retention Emergency Amendment Act of 2020, effective January 13, 2020 (D.C. Act 23-605; 68 DCR 1213) which expires on April 12, 2021. (b) On December 15, 2020, the Council adopted the Displaced Workers Right to Reinstatement and Retention Amendment Act of 2020 on second reading (D.C. Act 23-591; 68

- 37 DCR 1177) ("permanent act"), which was transmitted to Congress on February 1, 2021 with a 38 projected law date of May 18, 2021.
- 39 (c) This identical emergency legislation, with an applicability of April 11, 2021, is 40 necessary to prevent a gap in the law between the expiration of the emergency act and the effective date of the permanent measure.
- 42 Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the circumstances in 43 section 2 constitute emergency circumstances, making it necessary that the Displaced Workers 44 Right to Reinstatement and Retention Congressional Review Emergency Amendment Act of 45 2021 be adopted after a single reading.
