Council Chairman Phil Mendelson announces the scheduling of a public roundtable of the Committee of the Whole on **PR 24-89**, the “Board of Directors of the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority Lucinda Babers Appointment Resolution of 2021” and **PR 24-93**, the “Board of Directors of the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority Thomas J. Bulger Alternate Member Reappointment Resolution of 2021.” The roundtable will be held on **Wednesday, April 7, 2021 at 9:30 a.m.** live via Zoom Video Conference Broadcast.

The stated purpose of PR 24-89 is to appoint Ms. Lucinda Babers to the Board of Directors of the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority (WMATA Board) for a term to end June 30, 2023. The stated purpose of PR 24-93 is to reappointment Mr. Thomas Bulger to the Board of Directors of the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority (WMATA Board) as an alternate member for a term to end June 30, 2024. The Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority (WMATA) is a regional instrumentality created through an interstate compact between the Commonwealth of Virginia, the State of Maryland, and the District of Columbia to plan, develop, finance, and operate a regional transportation system in the Washington metropolitan area. The WMATA Board serves as the governing body for WMATA and is composed of Principal Directors and Alternate Directors appointed by the Council of the District of Columbia, the Northern Virginia Transportation Commission, the Washington Suburban Transit Commission, and the Secretary of the United States Department of Transportation. The purpose of this hearing is to receive testimony from public witnesses as to the fitness of the proposed two Council appointees for the WMATA Board.

Those who wish to testify must register at <http://www.ChairmanMendelson.com/testify> by 5:00 p.m. on Monday, April 5, 2021. **Testimony is limited to four minutes.** Witnesses who anticipate needing spoken language interpretation, or require sign language interpretation, are requested to inform the Committee office of the need as soon as possible but no later than five business days before the proceeding. We will make every effort to fulfill timely requests, although

Due to the COVID-19 public health emergency declaration, the roundtable will be conducted virtually on the Internet utilizing Zoom video conference technology. Because of this, written or transcribed testimony from the public is highly encouraged and will be taken by email or voicemail.
