Section 3, page 2, lines 37-46 is repealed.

## **Fiscal Impact:**

This amendment will not have a fiscal impact.

## **Rationale:**

This amendment removes from the bill the requirement for the Department of Health Care Finance to contract with at least 3 Medicaid providers, leaving the agency and the Office of Contracting and Procurement the discretion to determine the number of providers, after reevaluating the contracting process for the District's Medicaid contract, as required by the Contract Appeals Board's decision in CAB No. P-1128.
