Council Chairman Phil Mendelson announces a public hearing before the Committee of the Whole on PR 24-229, “Zoning Commission Robert Miller Confirmation Resolution of 2021.” The hearing will be held on **Thursday, June 24, 2021 at Noon**, via zoom video conference.

The stated purpose of **PR 24-229** is to confirm the re-appointment of Robert Miller to the Zoning Commission. The Zoning Commission is charged with preparing, adopting, and subsequently amending the Zoning Regulations and Zoning Map in a means not inconsistent with the Comprehensive Plan for the National Capital. The Zoning Commission also considers a variety of zoning cases such as Planned Unit Developments, campus plans, and may consider, *sua sponte*, Board of Zoning Adjustment cases. The purpose of this hearing is to receive testimony from government and public witnesses as to the fitness of this nominee for reappointment to the Commission.

Those who wish to testify must register at <http://www.ChairmanMendelson.com/testify> by 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, June 22, 2021. **Testimony is limited to four minutes**. Witnesses who anticipate needing spoken language interpretation, or require sign language interpretation, are requested to inform the Committee office of the need as soon as possible but no later than five business days before the proceeding. We will make every effort to fulfill timely requests, although alternatives may be offered. Requests received in less than five business days may not be fulfilled. Due to the COVID-19 public health emergency declaration, the hearing will be conducted virtually on the Internet utilizing Zoom video conference technology. Because of this, written or transcribed testimony from the public is highly encouraged and will be taken by email or voicemail.
