Council Chairman Phil Mendelson announces the scheduling of a public roundtable of the Committee of the Whole on **PR 24-88**, the "District of Columbia Retirement Board Lyle M. Blanchard Reappointment Resolution of 2021" and **PR2 4-358**, the "District of Columbia Retirement Board Adam Weers Appointment Resolution of 2021." The roundtable will be held on **Wednesday, October 20, 2021 at 2:30 p.m.** live via Zoom Video Conference Broadcast.

The stated purpose of PR 24-88 is to re-appoint Mr. Lyle Blanchard to the District of Columbia Retirement Board. The stated purpose of PR 23-358 is to appoint Mr. Adam Weers to the District of Columbia Retirement Board. The Board is an independent agency of the District of Columbia government with exclusive authority to manage the pension funds of the D.C. Police Officers and Firefighters' Retirement Fund and the Teachers' Retirement Fund. DCRB also is the benefits administrator for the plans associated with each fund. The current value of the funds is approximately \$10 billion.

Those who wish to testify must register at <http://www.ChairmanMendelson.com/testify> by 5:00 p.m. on Monday, October 18, 2021. **Testimony is limited to four minutes.** Witnesses who anticipate needing spoken language interpretation, or require sign language interpretation, are requested to inform the Committee office of the need as soon as possible but no later than five business days before the proceeding. We will make every effort to fulfill timely requests, although alternatives may be offered. Requests received in less than five business days may not be fulfilled. Due to continuing guidance concerning large indoor gatherings due to COVID-19, the roundtable will be conducted virtually on the Internet utilizing Zoom videoconference technology.
