14 To declare the existence of an emergency with respect to the need to establish boundaries for  
15 Advisory Neighborhood Commission areas and single-member districts within Advisory  
16 Neighborhood Commission areas, and to provide for each Advisory Neighborhood  
17 Commission to be the successor-in-interest to the assets, obligations, and legal interests  
18 of its predecessor.

20 RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this  
21 resolution may be cited as “Advisory Neighborhood Commission Boundaries Emergency  
22 Declaration Resolution of 2022”.

23 Sec. 2. (a) The Advisory Neighborhood Commission Boundaries Emergency Act of 2022  
24 redraws Advisory Neighborhood Commission boundaries and the Single Member Districts  
25 within them.

26 (b) It is necessary to adopt the boundaries on an emergency basis because the Board of  
27 Elections needs the final boundaries in place no later than June 14, 2022 in order to update the  
28 Districts election databases for the upcoming November election, including allowing individuals  
29 to circulate nominating petitions to run for office which would be made available by July 20,  
30 2022. Petitions would be due by August 10, 2022.

31 Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the circumstances  
32 enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that the

33 Advisory Neighborhood Commission Boundaries Emergency Act of 2022 be adopted after a  
34 single reading.

35           Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
