I. BACKGROUND AND NEED

Proposed Resolution 21-465, the “Citizens Review Panel on Child Abuse and Neglect Michelle A. McLeod Appointment Resolution of 2016,” was introduced by Chairman Mendelson on December 10, 2015 and referred to the Committee of the Whole. The purpose of PR 21-465 is to confirm the Council’s nomination of Michelle A. McLeod for appointment as a member of the Citizens Review Panel on Child Abuse and Neglect as a Council appointee for a three-year term.

The Citizens Review Panel on Child Abuse and Neglect (“Panel”) was established by the Child in Need of Protection Amendment Act of 2004 “to serve as an external, independent oversight body for the District’s child welfare system, evaluating the strengths and weaknesses of the District government agencies involved in child protection as well as neighborhood-based

services provided by vendors.”¹ In addition to Council appointees, members of the Panel include mayoral appointees.² The Panel’s chairperson is to be appointed by the Mayor, and the vice-chairperson appointed by the Council.³

Ms. McLeod is currently a Ward 6 resident and is currently a trial attorney at the Department of Justice. She is a graduate of the University of Maryland School of Law, where she earned a Juris Doctor. Ms. McLeod also holds a Bachelor of Science in Journalism from the East Carolina University. Ms. McLeod was a ward of the State of Maryland as a child, and her personal experience informs her desire to improve the lives of children involved in child welfare systems. In addition, she has worked in an informal capacity with the Panel during the past year. This experience should equip her to contribute successfully to the Panel’s work going forward.

The Committee of the Whole recommends her appointment.

V. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY

Pursuant to Council Rule 275, the Chairman nominates individuals for appointment to other bodies, and pursuant to the Child in Need of Protection Amendment Act of 2004, the Council must act by resolution on nominations to the Citizens Review Panel on Child Abuse and Neglect. Pursuant to Council Rule 501, a hearing or roundtable is not required on a proposed resolution.

The Committee received no testimony or comments on PR 21-465.

VI. IMPACT ON EXISTING LAW

Members of the Citizens Review Panel on Child Abuse and Neglect are appointed pursuant to section 351 of the Prevention of Child Abuse and Neglect Act of 1977, effective April 12, 2005 (D.C. Law 15-341; 52 DCR 2315), which established the Panel.

VII. FISCAL IMPACT

The approval of PR 21-465 will have no fiscal impact. Members are not compensated by the District government and the operations of the Citizen Review Panel on Child Abuse and Neglect are not funded through the District government.
