I. BACKGROUND AND NEED

Proposed Resolution 21-467, the “Children and Youth Investment Trust Corporation Board of Directors Reappointment Resolution of 2016,” was introduced by Chairman Mendelson on December 10, 2015 and referred to the Committee of the Whole. The purpose of PR 21-467 is to confirm the Council’s reappointment of Fred Taylor as a member of the Children and Youth Investment Trust Corporation Board of Directors as a Council appointee for a term to end May 30, 2017.

The Children and Youth Investment Trust Corporation (“CYITC”) was established by the Service Improvement and Fiscal Year 2000 Budget Support Act of 1999 as “a single non-service provider, non-profit organization of which at least 95% shall be used to make sub-grants for the purpose of providing services to District children, youth and their families, including, but not limited to, early childhood development opportunities, safe and enriching centers of learning in

and out of school, and other training, recreational and educational services”¹ In addition to Council appointees, members of the Board include mayoral appointees.²

Mr. Taylor is currently a Ward 5 resident and has extensive experience in the area of child welfare. He is a graduate of the Yale Divinity School, where he earned a Master of Divinity. Mr. Taylor also holds a Bachelor of Arts from Vanderbilt University. Mr. Taylor has served on the Board since 2013. This experience equips him to continue to contribute successfully to the Panel’s work going forward.

The Committee of the Whole recommends his reappointment.

VI. IMPACT ON EXISTING LAW

Members of the Children and Youth Investment Trust Corporation Board of Directors are appointed pursuant to section 2404 of the Service Improvement and Fiscal Year 2000 Budget Support Act of 1999, effective October 20, 1999 (D.C. Law 13-38; 46 DCR 6408), which established the CYITC.

VII. FISCAL IMPACT

The approval of PR 21-467 will have no fiscal impact. Members are not compensated by the District government.
