(c) New section 18a is added to read as follows:

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- "Sec. 18a. Vacant buildings belonging to foreign governments.
- "(a) The Department of Consumer and Regulatory Affairs shall publish and deliver semiannually to the Council, the Mayor, and the United States Department of State Office of Foreign Missions a list identifying each building belonging to a foreign government and used for legation purposes, as determined by the United States Department of State Office of Foreign Missions, that is registered as, or has been determined to be, vacant or blighted pursuant to this act.
 - "(b) Nothing in this act shall be construed to impose any obligation on any foreign government relating to any building belonging to that foreign government and used for legation purposes, as determined by the United States Department of State Office of Foreign Missions.".
 - Sec. 3. Section 47-1011 of the District of Columbia Official Code is amended by striking the phrase "owned by foreign governments for legation purposes" and inserting the phrase "belonging to a foreign government and used for legation purposes" in its place.
- Sec. 4. Fiscal impact statement.
 - The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement in the committee report as the fiscal impact statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975, approved October 16, 2006 (120 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47a).
- Sec. 5. Effective date.
 - This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of Congressional review as provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the District of Columbia Register.
