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11 IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA
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15 To amend section 47-362 of the District of Columbia Official Code to state that intra-District
16 transfers shall not be used to establish new programs or to change allocations specifically
17 denied, limited, or increased by the Council in the budget act, or the accompanying
18 budget report or mark-up sheets.
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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this
21 act may be cited as the "Intra-District Transfer Limitation Amendment Act".

22 Sec. 2. Section 47-362(b) of the District of Columbia Official Code is amended by
23 striking the phrase "Reprogrammings shall" and inserting the phrase "Reprogrammings or intra-
24 District transfers shall" in its place.

25 Sec. 3. Fiscal impact statement.

26 The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement in the committee report as the fiscal
27 impact statement required by section 4a of the General Legislative Procedures Act of 1975,
28 approved October 16, 2006 (12 Stat. 2038; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.47a).

29 Sec. 4. Effective date.

30 This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the
31 Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of congressional review as
32 provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December

33 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02(c)(1)), and publication in the District of
34 Columbia Register.

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
