23	Sec. 2. Section 47-3503(c)(4) of the District of Columbia Official Code is amended as
24	follows:
25	(a) The existing text is designated as subparagraph (A)
26	(b) A new subparagraph (B) is added to read as follows:
27	"(B) Notwithstanding subparagraph (A) of this paragraph, a homeowner of
28	a condominium unit at the River East at Grandview Condominiums located at 1262 Talbert
29	Street, SE, situated in square 5807, lots 2047 through 2092, whose application to the Lower
30	Income Homeownership Exemption Program was accepted and approved by the Office of Tax
31	and Revenue shall receive the real property tax exemption prescribed under this section for the
32	earlier of the homeowner's displacement from the property, or the conclusion of tax year 2023.

41	section 412(a) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87
42	Stat. 788; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.12(a)).
43	(b) This act shall expire after 225 days of its having taken effect.
