Council Chairman Phil Mendelson announces a roundtable before the Committee of the Whole on PR 24-1038, the “Historic Preservation Review Board Matthew Bell Confirmation Resolution of 2022.” The roundtable will be held at **1:00 p.m. (or immediately following the preceding hearing)** on **Monday, November 21, 2022** via Zoom Video Conference.

The stated purpose of PR 24-1038 is to confirm the reappointment of Matthew Bell as an Architect member of the Historic Preservation Review Board (“Board”). Mr. Bell who first appointed to the Board in November 2020. The Board is the official body of advisors appointed by the Mayor to guide the government and public on the preservation of historic buildings and property in the District of Columbia. The Board also assists with the implementation of federal preservation programs and the review of federal projects in the District. The purpose of this roundtable is to receive testimony from the nominees and public witnesses as to the fitness of this nominee for continued service on the Board.
