#### Conclusion

Funds are sufficient to implement this amendment. This subtitle will increase local revenue by \$25,791,000 in Fiscal Year 2023, \$78,254,000 in Fiscal Year 2024 and \$409,178,000 over the four-year financial plan.

## Background

For commercial or mixed-use (Class 2) property valued at over \$2 million, properties pay the following deed recordation and transfer taxes:

<b>Recordation Tax</b>	1.45%	1.05%	2.5%

On October 1, 2023, the additional rate is set to sunset, restoring the total deed and recordation tax rate for Class 2 properties at the pre-FY 2020 rate of 2.9%.<sup>2</sup>

This amendment extends the imposition of the additional rate, rate until September 30, 2029; leaving the total tax rate for Class 2 properties at 5% until that new sunset date.

The revenue raised by the amendment is as follows:
