25	act may be cited as the "Protecting Adjacent and Adjoining Property Owners from Construction
26	Damage Second Congressional Review Emergency Amendment Act of 2024".
27	Sec. 2. Section 6a(a)(2A) of the Construction Codes Approval and Amendments Act of
28	1986, effective April 20, 1999 (D.C. Law 12-261; D.C. Official Code § 6-1405.01(a)(2A)(B)), is
29	amended to read as follows:

40	"(ii) An alteration and repair permit pursuant to which the				
41	applicant will be engaging in underpinning, construction at the property line or on the party wall				
42	of an adjacent or adjoining property, or any construction activity for which a permit listed under				
43	sub-subparagraph (iii), (iv), (v), (vi), (vii), or (viii) of this subparagraph would otherwise be
