

A RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To approve the multiyear extension of Contract No. CFOPD-20-C-014 with Fidelity Information Services, LLC to continue to provide Electronic Benefits Transfer (EBT) services on behalf of the District of Columbia's Office of Finance and Treasury, for the Human Services Benefit program managed by the District of Columbia Department of Human Services.

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the "Contract No. CFOPD-20-C-014, Extension Approval and Payment Authorization Approval Resolution of 2026."

Sec. 2. (a) Pursuant to Section 451 of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 803; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.51) and section 202 of the District of Columbia Procurement Practices Reform Act of 2010, effective April 8, 2011 (D.C. Law 18-0371; D.C. Official Code § 2-352.02), the Council approves the extension of Contract No. CFOPD-17-C-009 for merchant services processing on behalf of the District of Columbia's Office of Finance and Treasury.

(b) The period of performance for the proposed multiyear option is June 1, 2026 through May 31, 2028. The proposed multi-year option cost is not to exceed \$5,372,426.00.
